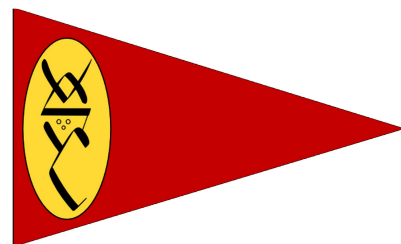


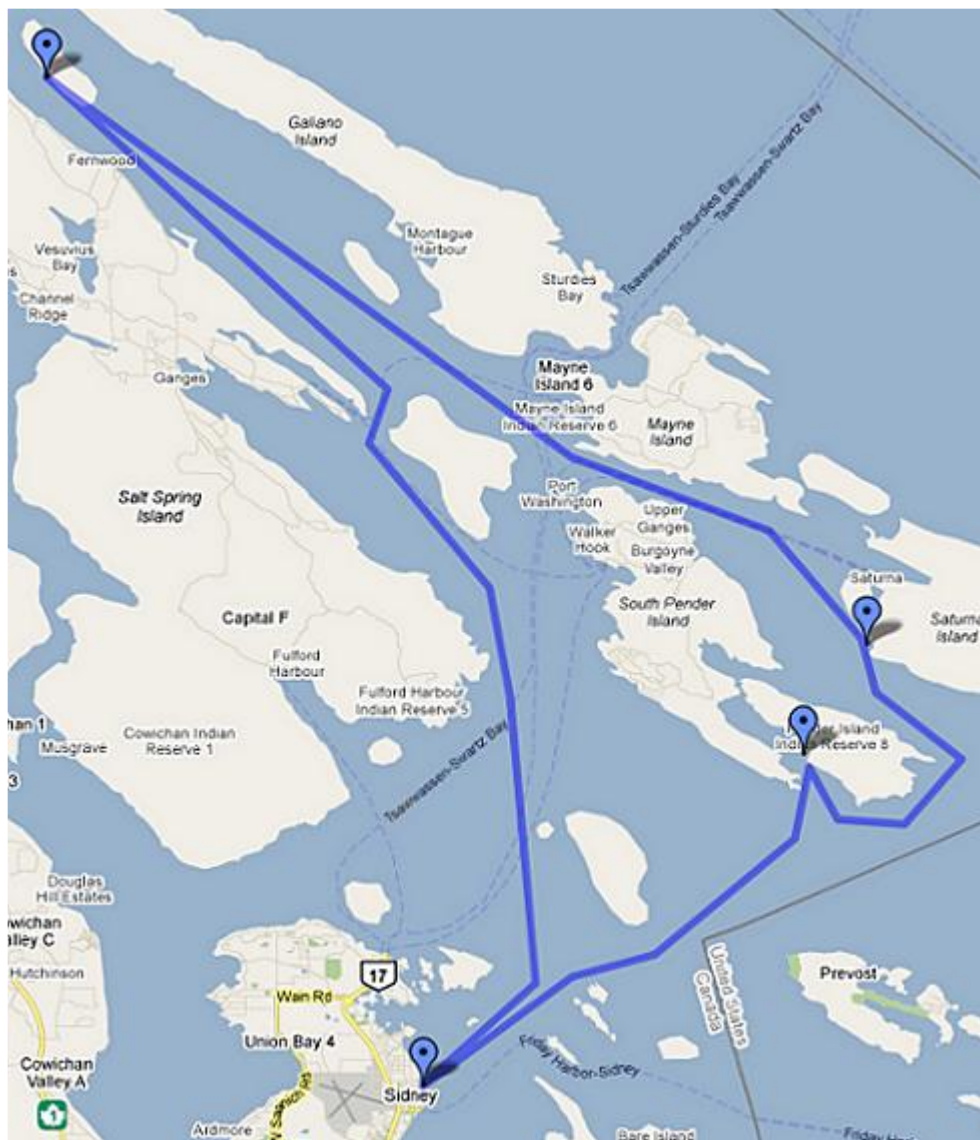
# Viking Sailing Club

## 2010 May Cruise - May 21 to 24

### Information and Registration

### Friday, May 21

Make your way to **Port Sidney on Vancouver Island**. Boats will be available to board between 1600 and 1800. We'll meet at the Rumrunner Pub for a meal and a drink. This year we are in walking distance to Thrifties and Safeway, so there's good choices to provisioning your boats.

### Saturday, May 22

We'll depart first thing for **Princess Cove on Wallace Island**. Wallace has a great park and walking trails to stretch your sea legs.

### Sunday, May 23

We'll make our way to **Poet's Cove Marina on South Pender Island**. For interested boats, we're planning a stop at Saturna Island to visit the Vineyard for a late lunch and tour (to be confirmed with enough interest).

### Monday, May 24

The fleet will make its way back to Sidney in time to clean up and catch a ferry back to Vancouver.

### The Basics ...

The cost is \$290 for members and \$335 for guests. This covers the cost of the charter. Provisioning is organized by your Skipper and is the cost is the shared responsibility of the boat (budget for three days of groceries, moorage, and a few other extras). Other costs, including eating out and alcohol, are your own. Each boat is equipped with refrigeration and cooking facilities.

**Who wants the helm?** This is a standard question on any Viking cruise. We're a teaching club and historically everyone was welcome to take a turn on the helm, whether they have 10 minutes or 10 years of sailing experience. However, government regulations now require anyone in control of a boat with a motor to have their Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC). If you don't have one, there's still plenty of opportunity to participate, but if you want to sit in the driver's seat, plan to get yours before the cruise.
